# **Practice Room Guidelines**

As noted in the "Columbus Wrestling Organization Team Brochure (2023-24 Season)" brochure, we have the following guidelines associated with CWO Wrestling Team practices:

<u>Pre-K – 2nd Grade:</u> Wrestlers will enter and exit the building through the doors on the northwest side of the high school. Park in the northeast parking lot and use the sidewalk on the north side of school for entering.

<u>3rd – 8th Grade:</u> Wrestlers will enter and exit the building through the doors on the west side of the high school just north of the loading docks. Park in one of the parking lots located west and south of school.

IN AN EFFORT TO MAXIMIZE THE AMOUNT OF SPACE IN THE WRESTLING ROOM AND KEEP DISTRACTIONS TO A MINIMUM ... PARENTS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN THE WRESTLING ROOM UNLESS PRE-APPROVED TO HELP AS A VOLUNTEER COACH. SIBLINGS (NON-WRESTLING) ARE ALSO NOT ALLOWED TO BE IN THE WRESTLING ROOM. THERE ARE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THESE RULES.

ALSO, PARENTS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO STAY IN THE HIGH SCHOOL HALLWAYS DURING PRACTICE. PARENTS ARE ASKED TO ONLY STAY LONG ENOUGH TO DROP OFF THEIR WRESTLER AT THE CHECK IN TABLE AND THEN RETURN 5-10 MINUTES BEFORE THE END OF PRACTICE TO PICK UP WRESTLER(S). PRACTICES WILL START AND END ON TIME TO ACCOMMODATE THESE REQUIREMENTMENTS.

# NOTE: ALL WRESTLERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR BRINGING THEIR OWN WATER BOTTLES AND KEEPING IT WITH THEM IN THE PRACTICE ROOM.

Another reminder that when coaches and/or wrestlers walk into the wrestling room, NO STREET SHOES ARE ALLOWED. Dirt and especially rocks/pebbles damage the surface of the mats. Please make sure your wrestlers change into their wrestling shoes AFTER they arrive at the high school. Please do not have your wrestler walk in his wrestling shoes directly from the parking lot into the wrestling room. This helps to avoid outside dirt and debris being brought into the wrestling room.

# **COVID Protocols**

CWO will follow the same protocols established by Columbus Public Schools for anyone who has tested positive for COVID and those who have been exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID.

# Hallways at Columbus High School

Please make sure your child does not run the halls at the school while waiting for either Team practice to begin or end. Please have them wait patiently in the hallway behind the check-in table. Everyone has done a great job with this and we would like to keep up the good work.

# Volunteer Coaches Needed

For those of you who have coaching and/or wrestling experience and would like to help out as a volunteer coach at practices and/or tournaments, we are in need of additional help, especially in the PreK-2<sup>nd</sup> grade group of wrestlers. If you don't have wrestling or coaching experience but have a desire to work with the kids, please consider volunteering and learning how to coach our wrestlers. Many of our coaches in the past had no wrestling experience and learned along the way with their child and ended up being some of our best coaches. ## Team Tournaments - CWO First Team Tournament

Our first official Team tournament will be this upcoming weekend on Sunday, January 14<sup>th</sup> in Schuyler, NE. The following weekend we will be taking a dual team the UNK Wrestling Duals in Kearney, NE and on Sunday be wrestling at the Lakeview tournament. A separate email will be sent out regarding the UNK dual tournament and how your wrestler can be a part of the CWO team that will go.

For each Team tournament, parents are responsible for sending in the tournament entry form along with payment or in some cases, registering them on-line. We will have coaches present at all Team tournaments for all age divisions. As noted above, CWO wrestlers are required to wear our Team singlets at designated Team tournaments. This shows pride in our Team and also makes our wrestlers more easily spotted at the tournaments by coaches, parents and fans.

To help our new parents and wrestlers, we have created a "CWO TOURNAMENT CHECKLIST FOR PARENTS AND WRESTLERS" document to help parents and wrestlers know what to do before, during and after tournaments including how to register for tournaments, how to check in and weigh in at the event and what to expect during tournaments.

## **Team Singlets**

We have custom designed lycra sublimated singlets for our wrestling team. The singlets will be distributed to those wrestlers who are a part of the Columbus Wrestling Organization Wrestling Team. We require our team singlets to be worn by our wrestlers during team tournaments. A deposit check of \$65 and the attached "CWO Singlet Liability Form (2023-24 Season)" will be required when the singlet is issued to your wrestler. Your wrestler can pick up a singlet in Room A119 for use during this year's season.

Singlets will be distributed to the Team starting Monday, January 8<sup>th</sup> at practice. PreK-2nd Grade are asked to get their singlets AFTER 7:15 p.m. and 3rd-8th grade are asked to get their singlets BEFORE 7:15 p.m. [NOTE: If you have been loaned out a singlet during pre-season wrestling, you MUST fill out a form and give a deposit check ASAP.]

The "CWO Singlet Liability Form (2023-24 Season)" is attached and will also be available at the check-in table if you do not have access to a printer.

# **Apparel Orders (Due date: TBD)**

Each wrestler will receive a free short-sleeve t-shirt if they participate on the Columbus Wrestling Organization Wrestling Team. For the parents and other family members, we have very reasonably priced t-shirts, sweatshirts, ½ zips and shorts available for ordering. We also have sackpacks available for the kids and adults to purchase. A flyer will be distributed via email once pricing information is sent to me from our vendor. We will send out the ordering information very soon.

# **USA Wrestling Insurance Cards**

Part of the CWO Team membership fees goes to purchasing each wrestler a USA Wrestling Insurance Card. This is secondary sports accident insurance (coverage is secondary to primary medical insurance) which we are required to carry as a youth sports organization. Many, if not all, of the tournaments we go to require proof of secondary sports insurance.
