CHS Wrestling State Qualifiers

A huge thank you to all the CWO wrestlers, parents, family members and fans who followed and supported the Columbus High School boys and girls wrestlers and their teams throughout this past season. Special thanks to those who came and supported them during the State tournament as well as those who were cheering by watching on-line or on tv.

Our CHS boys team placed 3^{rd} in a very competitive Class A team race and had six medalists including two State Champions. Those who medaled included Brenyn Delano – State Champion, Laitenn Braithwait – 6^{th} place, Mason Petersen – State Champion, Kaden Brownlow – 4^{th} Place, Jaeston Delano – 2^{nd} place and Tyler Zwingman – 6^{th} place. This was the first time since 1991 that CHS had two State Champions in the same year.

Our CHS girls team had its very first state medalist this weekend with Ella May Shevlin finishing in 6th place. What a great accomplishment to be the first girl to have her name placed on the wall in the wrestling room.

Congratulations again to all of our State qualifiers that battled for a place on the medal stand ... they all did CWO and CHS proud! We plan to introduce our boys and girls State medalists to the CWO wrestlers at 7:15 p.m. on Thursday, February 22nd, 2024.

Nebraska USA Wrestling District 3 Tournament

This tournament is scheduled for Saturday, March 2nd, 2024 in O'Neill. We will be going to this tournament as a team. I am strongly encouraging **everyone** to attend this tournament and make every effort to qualify for the USA State Tournament. Wrestlers can't go to the State Tournament without going through the District Tournament. Those who qualify will advance to the Nebraska USA State Folkstyle Tournament on Saturday, March 16th and Sunday, March 17th (in Grand Island). The State Tournament is also a qualifier for the Middle School National Dual Team and the Elementary National Dual Team. Registrations must be done on-line through TrackWrestling.

To qualify for NEUSAW State, the following applies:

- All wrestlers, all age groups, boys and girls, must participate in the District 3 tournament
- All girls, K-2, 3-5 and 6-8 grade, automatically qualify for State
- PreK-K boys, automatically qualify for State
- Boys in grades 1-2, 3-4, 5-6 and 7-8 must place top 4 at Districts to qualify
